

## **Admission Procedure For M. Sc. Forensic Odontology**

### **Intake of Students:**

The intake capacity for M.Sc. Forensic Odontology is 35 students.

Duration of course: 2 years

### **Eligibility for Admission:**

- The candidate should be holding a Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) with minimum 55% and for SC/ST candidates minimum 50% of marks from any institution recognized by the Dental Council of India.

### **Application Format:**

Candidate need to apply online ([www.gfsu.edu.in](http://www.gfsu.edu.in)) and final printed copy should be submitted along with the online payment of **Rs.1200/-** (non-refundable). The candidate needs to send the online transaction receipt along with the printed copy of application. Applicant must write his/her complete name on the backside of the Demand Draft. The following documents (**self-attested**) should be attached with application form:

1. Graduation mark sheets (for entire course)
2. State dental council registration certificate OR provisional degree certificate (Candidate will have to produce DCI registration certificate at the time of final admission)
3. Proof of age (School leaving OR class 10<sup>th</sup> provisional certificate)
4. Caste certificate (In case of SEBC/OBC/SC/ST)
5. Certificate for non-inclusion in Creamy Layer of current year (In case of SEBC/OBC)

### **Admission Procedure:**

Admissions will be based on the merit obtained in the Entrance Test conducted by the Gujarat Forensic Sciences University and marks obtained in graduation in ratio of 60:40 respectively.

**Note:** No entrance test will be conducted, if the total number of applications is less than double the seats and hence the admissions will be based only on the merit obtained in the qualifying degree.

### **Format for Entrance Exam:**

The entrance examination will be conducted by Gujarat Forensic Sciences University (GFSU) at its campus at Gandhinagar.

The examination will comprise of multiple choice questions of 200 marks.

There shall be no negative marks.

The duration of the examination will be 2.5 hours

The syllabus weightage details are as follows:

<b>Syllabus</b>	<b>Weightage</b>
Reasoning/Aptitude	25%
Basic Forensic Science and Forensic Dentistry	25%
Subjects taught during BDS program	50%

### **Preparation of Merit list:**

The merit will be calculated as under

Graduation marks: **40% weightage**

Entrance Examination: **60% weightage**

(**Note:** Merit will be prepared fully based on graduation marks **if entrance test is not conducted**)

**Reservation of Seats:** The seats shall be reserved for the candidate who are origin of Gujarat and falling under the following categories, namely:-

- a) Scheduled Caste : 7%
- b) Scheduled Tribe :15%
- c) Socially and Educationally Backward Class (OBC/SEBC): 27%

A candidate seeking admission on reserved seat shall be required to produce a Certificate of Caste from which he originates. Provided that a candidate belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Class shall be required to produce a certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in Creamy Layer in addition to the caste certificate. No caste certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the government of Gujarat. If a candidate fails to submit the certificates as required under above mention rules within the stipulated time, his candidature shall be considered for admission under unreserved category.

The admission of a student of reserved category on a reserved seat shall be valid subject to the verification of caste certificate by the authority empowered by the State Government in this behalf. In case the caste certificate is found invalid on verification, he shall not have right to claim his admission on reserved seat and if he has been already granted admission, such admission shall be cancelled.

After granting admission to all the students of reserved categories on reserved seats, the vacant reserved category seats shall be transferred to the unreserved category seats.

### **Fees Structure:**

- Semester Tuition fee: Rs.40,000/- per semester + Other university fees

### **Submission of Application Form:**

The final printed application (after the online application) along with the Online Payment Receipt is to be sent by last date specified in a sealed envelope marked as “M.Sc. Forensic Odontology Admission-2018” on the left hand side top corner of the envelope can be submitted either in person or by registered post or by courier on the following address. The application received after the due date will not be considered for admission.
