Candidates eligible as per UGC norms are invited for **Walk-in-Interview** for the post of Assistant Professor for various streams of forensic science on **CONTRACTUAL** basis at GFSU, Gandhinagar. Interested candidates should reach the GFSU admin. Office between **10.00AM to 11.00AM** on scheduled date of the interview. They should bring their complete bio-data (in the prescribed proforma available at www.gfsu.edu.in), passport size photograph, original certificates in support of their educational/professional qualifications.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject (mentioned below) or allied/relevant disciplines from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

- b) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET/SET/SLET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR.
- c) Notwithstanding anything contained in (b) above candidates, who are, or have been awarded a PhD Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of PhD Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET.
- d) NET/SET/SLET shall also not be required for such Master Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET/SLET is not conducted.

Note:

- i. The applicant must ensure that he/she possesses required qualification as per UGC Norms.
- ii. For the post of Assistant Professor * in Clinical Psychology eligibility shall be as per RCI Norms.
- iii. No TA/DA shall be provided to the candidate for attending the interview.
- iv. The selected candidates shall be required to join the services immediately.
- v. Number of posts in each discipline can be increased or decreased.
- vi. The eligible candidates may be screened through written test at 11.00 am and only shortlisted candidates who qualify the written test will be interviewed by the selection committee.
- vii. Minimum fulfillment of minimum qualifications does not entitle any candidate for appointment and the selection will be made purely on the basis of performance in the interview.
- viii. The prescribed qualification and experience will be minimum, and the mere fact that a candidate possessing the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview.
- ix. The University will have the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview, based on the recommendations of the Screening Committee constituted as per the Regulations for this purpose, to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit.
- x. The Scrutiny Committee for applications may evolve criteria for shortlisting the candidates to be called for the interview as per the UGC /Government / University norms in consultation with the Director General of GFSU.
- xi. Ph D should be in a regular mode as per the UGC guidelines 2016.
